Statement by Senator Robert L. Hedlund on the Senate President clearing the Senate gallery

Boston, MA – "I am disappointed that Senate President Therese Murray cleared the entire Senate gallery when a group of spectators cheered wildly to express their displeasure regarding a bill being debated that would raise taxes \$500 million dollars.
